Schoolwide Areas of Strength as Identified by the Visiting Committee

Domain 1: Mission and Catholic Identity

- St. Patrick Catholic School is an excellent school that is guided by a clearly communicated mission that embraces a Catholic Identity rooted in Gospel values and committed to faith formation and academic excellence
- St. Patrick's Catholic faith is prominent in visuals, teaching and practice.
- Students pray before meals and at the end of the day with their classroom teacher. Each Tuesday, a "faith community" is led by students.

Domain 2: Governance and Leadership

- The school has benefited from a close and supportive relationship with the Diocesan Office of Education.
- Both school and pastoral leadership are collaborating toward school sustainability.
- The decision to focus on an English-Spanish dual language program demonstrates that St. Patrick's leadership is responsive to the needs and desires of the parish and surrounding community.

Domain 3: Academic Excellence

- Students are the center of classroom instruction.
- The school and classroom community see the pupil as key, their social and emotional needs are taken into consideration in lesson development and instruction.
- Faculty and staff collaborate to support students in academics and spirituality

Domain 4: Operational Vitality

- The St. Patrick's team is committed to developing a comprehensive strategic plan encompassing finances, enrollment, personnel, technology, facilities, advancement and development to ensure school sustainability.
- Tuition assistance and scholarship opportunities are well published to offer opportunities for student enrollment.
- The Parish leadership is very supportive of St. Patrick's School.

Critical Growth Areas as Identified by the School Self-Study

• Create a faith community centered on the new school mission by enriching the spiritual formation of faculty, parents and students.

- Maintain school leadership at the School Advisory Council level by developing and implementing a program of recruitment to serve on the SAC, and council formation opportunities.
- Ensure the achievement of mission goals of academics, faith, and community by focusing on school-home communication, faith formation for staff and collaboration amongst teachers.
- Develop a comprehensive five-year plan that includes budget projection, enrollment projections, marketing goals and development plans.
